#### **Mental Health and Workplace Safety**

For many years it was considered taboo to talk about mental health at work and other public places. Fortunately, the stigma over talking about mental health is changing and CFMA is working to be a leader in this.

It is important to treat mental health like we do physical health. We do not blame individuals for getting sick so we should be accepting of individuals who may be struggling with mental health issues. People affected by mental illness are not alone or uncommon – 1 in 5 adults deal with a mental health condition. People at-risk for suicide are not weak and should not feel shame – they are in a place of hopelessness and we can show them that they are important and cared for.

Two mental health conditions that are most frequently observed in the workplace are depression and anxiety. Coworkers that are affected by these conditions may exhibit a

lack of focus, slower reaction times, and impaired decision-making. Out of concern for their safety and the safety of your entire crew, connecting them with help if they are in need benefits not only the affected employee but the entire company.

Checking in with your crewmates to let them know you care demonstrates respect and concern for their well-being. Taking time to listen or being patient can go a long way to making people feel respected and cared for. CFMA leadership supports employees taking the time to care for one another.
